Thank you for your interest in *St. Tammany Art Association & the City of Covington's Art Market*. Below you will find general information, guidelines and application for our Spring and Fall Art Market seasons. Please email info@sttammanyartassociation.org or call (985) 892-8650 for more information.

The Covington Art Market is held six times per year on the first Saturdays of March, April, May, October, and November, and the first Sunday in December. If you have already been juried and approved to previous markets, please complete and email this form with your date preferences and submit payment no later than two weeks prior to the market. All artists, new and old, are subject to our jury process for each market. This is in no way a comment or judgment on the quality of the submission. It is our goal to present a diverse, yet well-balanced art market. If this is your first time entering, please submit completed entry form and sample digital images by submission deadline date. You will be notified within one week of the jury decision. **ALL ARTISTS, PLEASE INDICATE IF YOU HAVE A TENT.** We have options available for artists with and without tents. Tented space: 10' x 10', located on sunlit side of alley (limited availability.) Non-tented booths located on shaded side of alley, 8' w x 6' deep.

- This is a juried Art Market. All submissions will be reviewed by a panel and notification of acceptance will be issued at approx. one - two weeks prior to market.
- **Please note that the location has moved to Art Alley on Columbia Street**, the space that runs between St. Tammany Art Association's Art House and H.J. Smith & Sons General Store.
- STAA membership is required to participate (see pricing discount below.)

Booth Information & Fees

- Each booth area is a 10'x10' space (with tent) or 8' w x 6' deep (without tent.) Fees:
 - \$35=Individual Booth Fee for current STAA Members
 - \$60=Two Person Booth Fee for current STAA members
 - \$65=Discounted Booth Fee AND 1-Year Individual Membership to STAA for new members/first-time vendors only.
- Only original, handmade and locally produced goods are permitted, and no reselling of other artwork or products is allowed.
- Certain reproductions are accepted with approval.
- Any sales tax collection is the responsibility of the individual vendor.
- You are responsible for providing materials you might need for your booth, such as tables, chairs, tents, etc.

Set Up & Take Down

- Set up will occur starting at 9:00 am on Saturday morning. You must be set up and ready to go by 10:00 am. **Booths must remain up until the end of the market.**
- Please check in at the Art House at 10 a.m.
- Street parking is available for vendors and guests. Artists will receive placement and parking maps 2-3 days prior to the market. *Please do not park in restricted areas indicated on map.*
- Unless otherwise indicated, the market ends at 2 p.m.

Images submitted must be representative of what you will present in your booth. **Do not submit printed photographs.**

ALL ARTISTS' SUBMISSIONS MUST BE RECEIVED AT STAA NO LATER THAN TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO MARKET DATE TO BE CONSIDERED.
